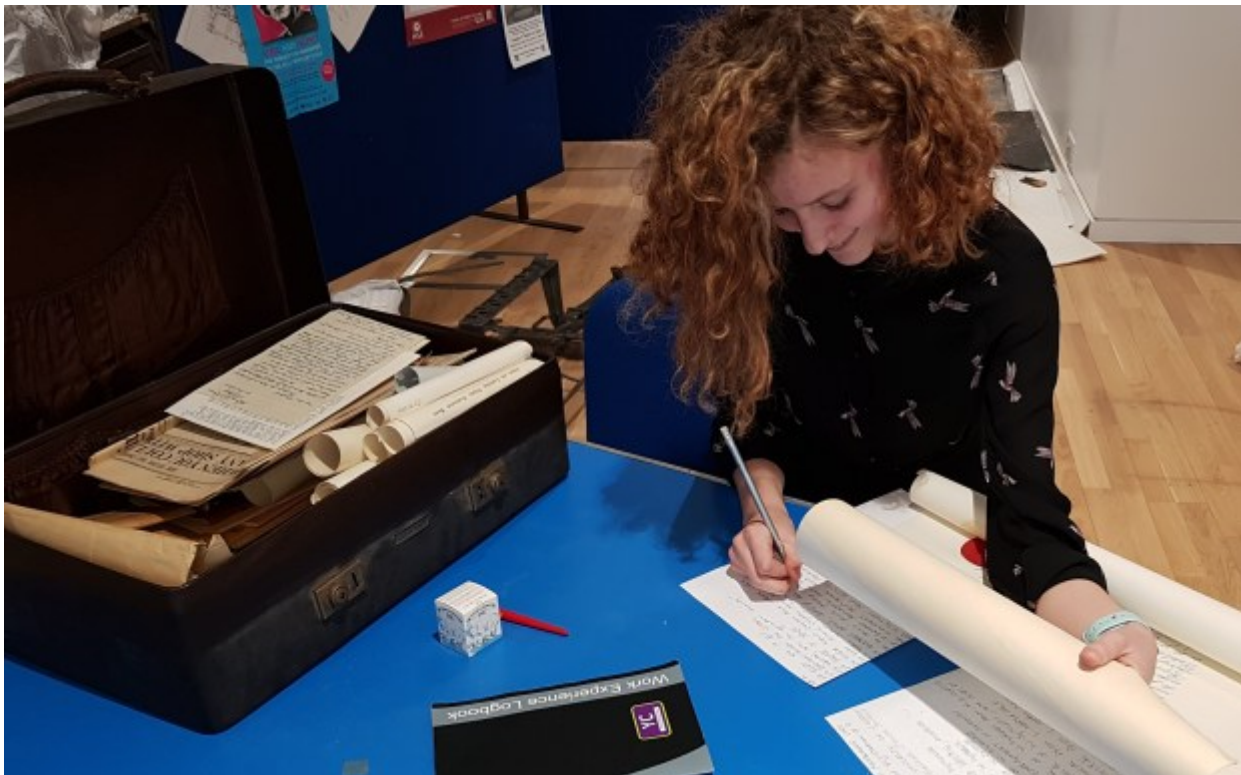


Guest post by Ellie McLean, work experience volunteer
